



Resources for Fall Leaf Disposal in Your Community

Agawam: Residential curbside collection 4 times in the fall based on route schedule; or drop off at Bondi's Island Landfill— entrance requires a town yard waste pass. More information: www.agawam.ma.us/292/Leaf-Yard-Waste

Belchertown: Transfer Station & Recycling Center, 135 Hamilton St. Open Tues., Wed., Fri. & Sat. 7:30 to 3:15; Thurs. 7:30 to 5:15. For more information: 413-323-0416. Permit required to enter Transfer Station.

Chicopee: Curbside yard waste is picked up bi-weekly, and can also be brought to: Chicopee Department of Public Works.; Tues. to Fri. 8 to 4:30; Sat. 8 to noon. No fee, but pre-registration required at www.chicopeema.gov/843

East Longmeadow: Transfer Station, 170 Somers Rd., Sat. 9 to 5 year-round. Wed. 9 to 5 seasonally (to be announced). Do not mix leaves with brush. More information: www.eastlongmeadowma.gov/198/Transfer-Station

Easthampton: Brush Dump located end of Oliver Street. Open to residents for yard waste (grass, leaves, and brush less than 6" diameter only) every Sat., Oct. through Nov., 8, from 8 a.m. to noon. Proof of residency required. More information: www.easthampton.org/services/trash-recycling.html

Holyoke: Holyoke Yard Waste Facility, 1 Berkshire St. Open to Holyoke residents only and hours vary by season. More information: www.holyoke.org/dpw-waste-and-recycling/

Longmeadow: off Birnie Road, 7 days a week 8am-5pm. Open 7 days a week from 8 to 5, beginning Oct. 17 through Dec. 6, 2020. More information: 413-567-3400. Annual recycling center sticker is required.

Northampton: Annual transfer station sticker required to access City's two leaf waste collection sites, both located off Glendale Rd. Leaves only accepted loose or in paper leaf bags. More information: www.northamptonma.gov/1821/Yard-Waste

Palmer: Compost collection area open weekends 9 to 5, starting Oct. 13-14 and ending Nov. 24-25. Leaves must be in brown paper bags. More information: 413-283-2615.

Southwick: Transfer Station, 22 Industrial Dr. Open Tues. 11:30 to 7:20, Wed. & Fri. 8 to 4:20, and Saturday 8 to 3:50. More information: 413-569-6772.

Springfield: Two options: residential curbside pick up on alternating weeks (same day as recycling) through December (place leaves loosely in barrel or in paper 30 gallon leaf bag; or Bondi's Island drop-off Mon. through Fri. 7:30 to 3:15, and Sat. 7 to noon. More information: 413-787-7840.

West Springfield: Drop off at the Transfer Station at 138 Palmer Ave., Mon. through Fri. 7AM to 3:30PM and Sat. 7AM to 1 PM. Proof of residency required. For more information call (413) 363-0090. Curbside collection occurs in the Spring and Fall. Westfield: Transfer Station, 57 Twiss St., Mon.-Sat 7-2:45. Must be loose or in paper leaf bags. NO BRUSH. Requires Annual Permit. More information: 413-572-6226.

Wilbraham: Disposal/Recycling Center, 2720 Boston Rd. Open to permit holders Wed. 7 to 3; Fri. 7 to 3; Sat. 7 to 5; Sun. 12 to 5. More information: 413-596-2800 x208.
